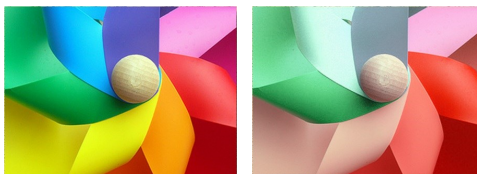


Many of these diseases can be well managed if identified early. If we identify patients at the onset of these diseases, we can better treat them.

## COLOR VISION MAY BE EARLIEST INDICATOR

In your doctor's goal to be proactive, the Rabin Cone Test was brought into the practice. The Rabin Cone Test is a revolutionary new test that detects subtle changes in the cone cells within your eyes.



Cone cells serve two roles. They allow us to see in sharp detail and in color. Over time, aging, hereditary and environmental factors may begin to cause very small changes in your color perception.

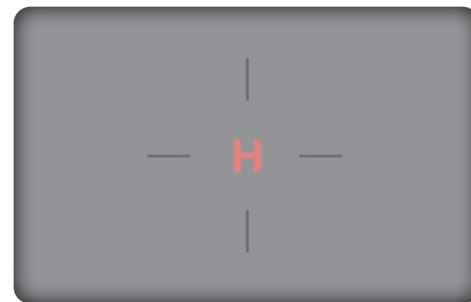
In the early stage of a disease, cone cells begin to lose their ability to function properly. Changes in color vision are so subtle you will likely be unaware any change is taking place;

and a regular comprehensive eye exam is not likely to detect it. During this stage, you could lose up to 50% of your vision before you notice something is wrong.

## THE RABIN CONE TEST FOR CONTINUED EYE HEALTH

Research over the last 30 years demonstrates that a change in color vision is often the first indicator of the need for additional care.

Your doctor uses the Rabin Cone Test to identify changes in your color vision that might otherwise be undetectable. Detecting abnormalities in color vision is important to ensure continued eye health.
